

Maundy Thursday Simple Supper & Worship Service

Thursday, April 17th

The last time Jesus had dinner with his disciples before his arrest, trial, and crucifixion was on Maundy Thursday. The term "Maundy" comes from the Latin word maundatum, meaning commandment, which refers to Jesus' statement that night, "I give you a new commandment; that you love one another..."

A very special worship service is planned to remember this supper on Thursday April 17th at 6:00 p.m. in the Fellowship Room. Participants will share a simple stew & bread supper at round tables as we move through a worship service reenactment of foot-washing, Jesus' teachings, and his last supper that we now know as communion. This is an interactive service and appropriate for all ages. We ask that you sign up on the bulletin board or call the church office to indicate your attendance so we can plan for our set up and food. Please join us!



Good Friday Tenebrae Service Friday, April 18th



Tenebrae is a Latin word meaning darkness or shadows, and the Tenebrae service of worship is held on Good Friday to remember the darkness that fell over the earth when Jesus was crucified. It is a solemn and reflective time of music, prayer, and silence.

We will make use of Taizé style music and readings from the Passion narrative as we gradually extinguish a series of candles to symbolize the coming darkness. Please join us at 7:00 pm on Friday, April 18th in the Sanctuary. If you'd like to be a reader, please speak to Pastor Katie by April 13.
